



4-H Arts & Craft Entry Form

The annual 4-H Arts & Craft Show provides an opportunity for 4-H members to use their creative energy in constructing hand-made items from assorted media. **Each 4-H members may enter up to 5 crafts, however only ONE craft per category is permitted.** This year, 4-H members may choose up to TWO of their craft entries for Conference Style Judging. All entries will receive ribbon recognition, however only items judged "Conference Style" will receive premiums. Arts and Craft entries are to be brought to the 4-H Exhibit Hall at the Fairgrounds between 2pm and 6pm on Tuesday, October 19th. Crafts will be displayed throughout the Fair. Crafts will be released between 4pm and 7pm on Sunday, October 24th. In choosing a category, the item must represent at least 50% of the material/technique for that category. The categories for the Arts & Craft Show include:

- 1. **Hand Crafts** (needle work, knitting, weaving, crewel...)
- 2. **Stuffed** (dolls, animals, pillows)
- 3. **Textiles** (appliqué, fabric painting, leather...)
- 4. **Holiday Themed Crafts**
- 5. **String and Beads** (jewelry, macramé...)
- 6. **Woodworking**
- 7. **Models** (represents something in smaller scale, can include diorama or shadow box)
- 8. **Recycle** (50% or more of craft is made of recycled materials)
- 9. **Baskets**
- 10. **Pottery, Ceramics, Clay, Paper Mache**
- 11. **Candles**
- 12. **Fine Art** (sketch or painting framed/mounted)
- 13. **General** (items that do not fit another category)

Please note that the "Exhibitor Release and Indemnification" form (found on the fair website) must be completed, notarized and submitted with this fair entry form.
