Welcome to Florida 4-H! We are excited that you have elected to join 4-H. As you complete your enrollment in your club, your next step is to select the “projects” for an exciting year of fun while learning new things. You can choose from more than ### different projects.

In selecting projects, think about:

- an interest you would like to explore
- a hobby you would like to learn more about
- a topic of interest shared by you and your family
- something that is fun for you

Remember to choose projects that you can get help from your

- parents/guardian
- grandparents
- friends
- other 4-H members and leaders

Projects help you to grow and to have real-life experiences. Project work is the “learn by doing” part of 4-H. Let’s say you want to learn how to build a birdhouse, take photographs, care for a dog, or learn to cook. When you learn those skills, you will also learn such life skills as:

- how to make decisions
- how to organize yourself, your time or your money
- how to work with and get along with others
- how speak in front of a group
- how to work together as a member of a team

4-H has lots of fun ways to learn beyond your project work and club meetings, too. There are camps, community service projects, club trips and county activities. So, let’s start by choosing a project. You can choose from those listed in this booklet. To enroll, once you have made your first 4-H decision, **list the name and project code on the 4-H Enrollment Form that your 4-H Leader will give you.**
